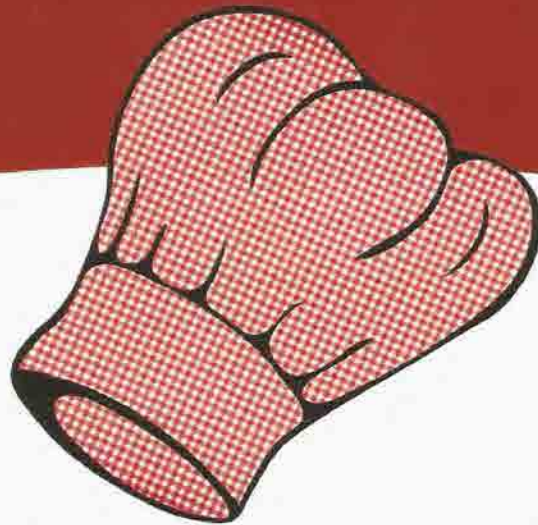

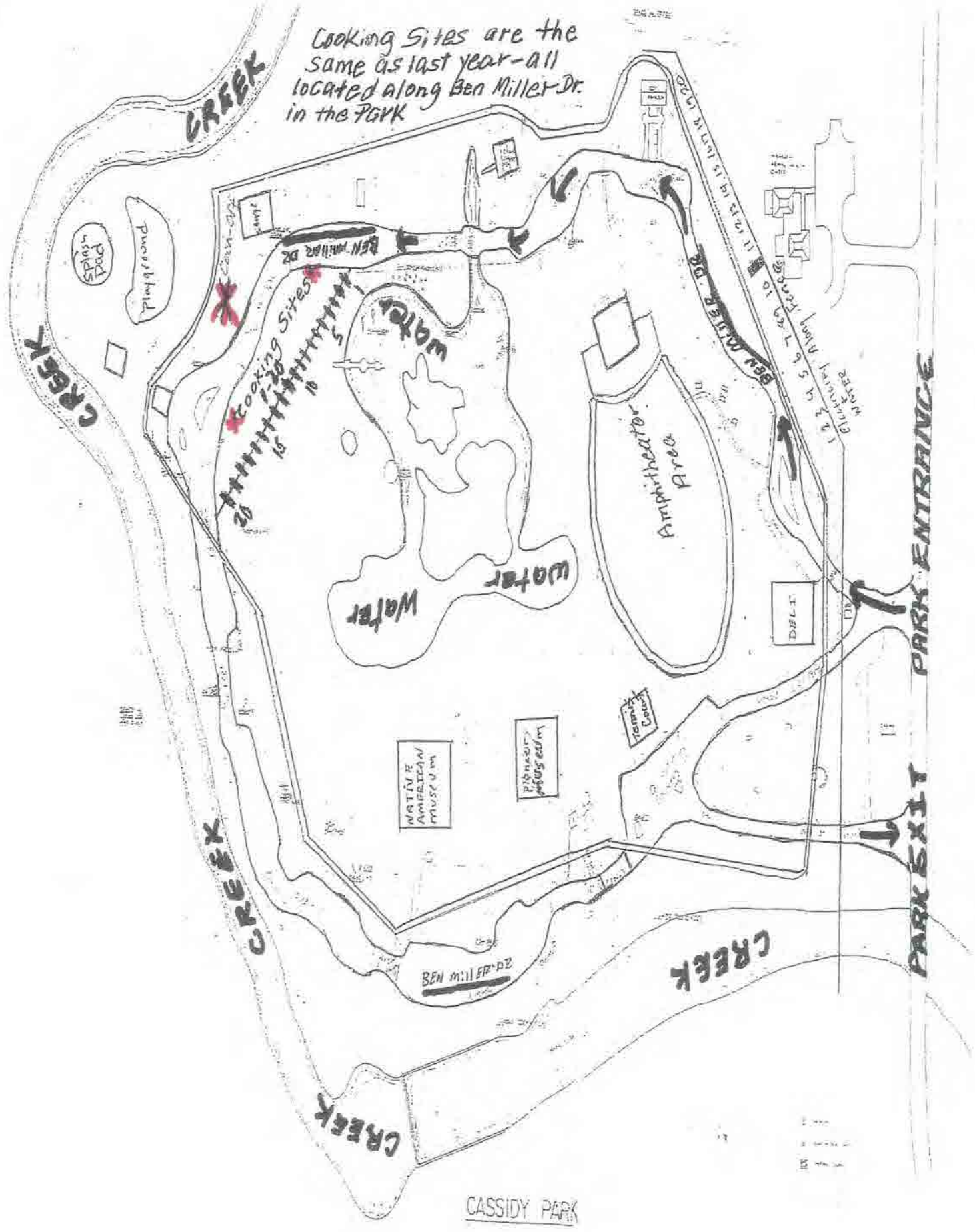

2014 COOK-OFF COMPETITION GUIDELINES

1. Entry Form must be filled out and submitted to the Cook-Off Committee by MARCH 1, 2014. The TEAM CAPTAIN will meet at the STAGE AREA at 9:00 a.m. on the day of the Cook-Off. TEAM CAPTAIN MUST ATTEND OR THE TEAM WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
2. Registration Fee of \$25.00 must accompany Entry Form.
3. "Working Chefs" will be allowed to cook, but not to compete. Be sure that you have no "working chef" on your team.
4. Teams may compete in multiple categories. Only one fee!! Categories may be changed up until MARCH 5, 2014. NO EXCEPTIONS!
5. Teams must prepare 200 portions/category entry.
6. The Cook-Off Committee will supply bowls, plates, plastic ware and napkins for serving. Each team will start out with 125 bowls and/or plates, plastic ware and napkins. Additional bowls and accessories will be readily available to all teams at a given site.
7. Teams must supply their own tent, cooking utensils and a serving table.
8. Food will be served from your table, so please decorate your table for serving.
9. Up to four members are allowed per team including the CAPTAIN. Four food bracelets will be issued for each team (be sure that you have listed your complete team on your entry form). ALL other persons in your cooking area must purchase a cook-off bracelet for \$10.00. This is a fund raiser for the Museums and we would appreciate your cooperation.
10. Only the cookers (those listed as a team) can bring in beer and soft drinks. Everyone else must purchase their beer and soft drinks at the event. Again.....this is a fundraising event.
11. All competition entries must be cooked on site. Water and electricity will be available at all sites.
12. Please be discreet with what your team will be cooking. Keep your entries to yourself!! It is only fair to everyone that the judges not know ahead of time what any particular team is preparing.

13. Advise the Contact Person at the bottom of this page of the time that your Team needs to be on-site so that we can be sure that your site is accessible. (Leave a message and number if Contact Person does not answer and your call will be returned.) Remember that the Team Captain must be on site by 9:00 a.m. for the meeting at the Stage. Please have all of your equipment set up by this time because extra vehicles will need to be removed from the area after this time. Anyone on the Cooking Team or with the Cooking Team should park outside of the Cooking Area after 9:00 a.m.
14. Food judging will begin at 1:00 p.m. and continue until 3:00 p.m. Your entry(s) must be ready to be judged by the time told to the team captain in the 9:00 meeting. Judging will be in this order: Seafood, Fowl, Pork, Beef and Wild Game last. A golf cart will pick up your entry at your designated time and deliver it to the judges. You are not to leave your booth to deliver your entry. That way judges and cooks will have no contact.
15. Presentation of Awards will immediately follow the judging of entries.
16. Serving to the public will follow the Award Presentation and will begin with the sound of the DINNER BELL (mill whistle). Serving will continue until 6:00 p.m. NO FOOD OR DRINKS SHOULD BE SERVED UNLESS A PERSON HAS A BRACELET ON ARM. Please honor this request....again, we need your cooperation.
17. You will be responsible for removing all of your equipment after the event.
18. If you would like to bring a camper, you may set up on Friday evening before the event or early Saturday morning. Please advise the contact person below....electricity and water hook-ups, but you may not be able to have your camper at your site.....depends on how many cooks.

Food Booth Rules & Regulations

1. The outside area of each booth must be policed daily.
2. The use of insecticides inside booths is prohibited.
3. The use of granite, enamel or galvanized containers for food prep. is prohibited.
4. All meat products must be processed at an approved agriculture inspected plant.
5. Ice is a food and must be handled properly.
6. **All food preparation must be under a covered area.**
7. All employees must wear hair restraints.
8. Employees with cuts or illness must work in an area other than food prep. & serving.
9. Proper refrigeration must be provided for storage or potentially hazardous food.
10. The reuse of chicken boxes is prohibited.
11. **Cover all foods while stored.**
12. Store all food items not in metal cans, plastic jars, or glass jars off the floor.
13. All single service items must be stored off the floor.
14. All sugar, cream, catsup, mustard, mayonnaise, etc., cannot be served from open vessels.
15. Dispensing milk must be from a dispenser or single service cartons.

Temporary Booths

1. All outside booths must have a wood, canvas or other cover impenetrable to rain.
2. All booths must have a canvas, plastic, wood, concrete, asphalt (or similar material) floor. It must be kept clean and in good repair.

JUDGING SCHEDULE

The times for the different category judging will be given at the 9:00 a.m. meeting of the Team Captains near the Stage Area. You will be advised at that time exactly when your entry will be picked up. If you have entered in more than one category you will be given different times for each category. That is why it is important and necessary that each Team Captain be present at the meeting. There will be 3 awards given in each category, as follows:

1st Place

2nd Place

3rd Place

There will also be a "People's Choice Award" given. This award is based on what the "tasters...people at the event" think is the over-all best entry.

Your entry(s) will be judged in 3 areas. They are Appearance, Taste and Tenderness. Please understand that there are sub-divisions under each area that the judges are advised to look for in your entry. For example: Included under Appearance judging would be Creativity and Originality. Below is an example of the judges' Score Card.
